

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Statement of Intent

APS customers in the mining and construction industries are committed to a high level of environmental performance. We can support our customers' commitment to the environment by:

- Supplying superior products that make the customers operations more efficient
- Ensuring that all APS employees working at customer sites proactively abide by all site regulations.
- Ensuring that all our activities on and off site are progressed with the maximum regard to environmental excellence.

To deliver on our commitment we will:

- communicate APS Environmental Policy and Procedures to all employees and other stakeholders.
- comply with all applicable environmental laws, regulations and statutory obligations.
- ensure that best practice environmental procedures are incorporated into all aspects of our operations;
- seek to achieve the personal commitment of all employees to environmental excellence.
- co-operate and comply with all customer environmental rules, systems and procedures.
- Pro-actively seek to continually improve our environmental practices.
- periodically review and revise our Environmental Policy and Procedures to maintain their relevance.

Specific Policies

Inductions

APS personnel must maintain up to date appropriate induction certificates for the states and industries in which they work. APS personnel must ensure that they obtain all necessary inductions at the sites at which they work.

Compliance with Site Environmental Requirements.

APS personnel working at customer sites must fully and completely comply with all site environmental requirements.

Directions from Site Personnel

At customer sites APS employees must follow the directions of responsible site personnel. If there is an issue with such directions it should be politely pointed out to the site personnel. Unresolved issues should be promptly reported to the CEO of APS.

Disposal of Waste

Any waste material from installations or generated as a result of APS activities on site should be properly disposed of in accordance with site regulations or removed from the site and properly disposed of elsewhere.

Technical Waste

Electronic equipment often contains exotic materials requiring special disposal. As far as possible defective GPS receivers, circuit boards, radios, sensors, specialist batteries and similar items should be returned to the manufacturer. If this is not possible they must be disposed in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.

Items Manufactured by APS

All items sold by APS will offer the customer the option that they may be returned to APS for safe disposal.

Customer Notification

At the time of installation, customers should be informed of APS disposal policy.

Minimisation of waste

All employees must give due consideration to reducing waste in our products.

Spill Reporting

APS employees working at customer sites must comply with site spill reporting policies. Any accident or incident involving liquid or solid spills on a customer's site where there is a possibility that APS may be held responsible should be promptly reported to the CEO.
